

COMMUNITY NOTICE WE WILL BE WORKING IN YOUR COMMUNITY

In order to provide a continued supply of safe and reliable power, Hydro One will be conducting routine vegetation maintenance on the electricity transmission corridor that begins at **St. Mary's Transformer Station (TS)** and extends through the Town (see map on reverse).

Routine vegetation maintenance incudes the trimming and removal of trees and brush to ensure safe clearances between lines and vegetation, and safe access for crews.

Tree and brush removal

Hydro One crews will use manual equipment like chainsaws and pruners to trim, prune and remove trees and brush. Support vehicles like bucket trucks and chippers will be used on site where necessary.


Tree replacement

Hydro One will work with the Town to support off-corridor tree replacement efforts with the goal of replanting more trees than will be removed.


This work will begin in February 2019 and we anticipate it will take two weeks to complete, weather permitting.
