



## Permission Form for Fire Truck Visits

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This form must be completed by every visitor. Children under 18 years of age must have Parent/Guardian Consent. Print and bring completed form with you on the day of your visit.

The \_\_\_\_\_ (name of community group) is arranging a visit of a fire truck from the St. Marys Fire Department. Fire truck visits provide the opportunity to meet the firefighters who are committed to public safety and to see first-hand the vehicles and equipment used on a daily basis. This is a great chance to learn about fire and life safety with professional fire department staff. Visits will last approximately 1 hour.

Please note that the crew and fire trucks are on active duty and may be called to an emergency response at any time. If this happens, visitors will obey the directions of fire department personnel. This can be a very loud process, including sirens and speakerphones. Please ensure that the children are aware of this happening.

This form must be read and signed by a parent or guardian for every child and by every person who wishes to participate.

Educational activity programs, such as fire truck visits involve certain elements of risk. The St. Marys Fire Department takes the appropriate steps to ensure visitor safety; however, the risk of sustaining injury can occur without any fault of either the student, the St. Marys Fire Department, the Town of St. Marys or its' employees. By choosing to take part in this activity, you are accepting the risk that you/your child may be injured. The chance of an injury occurring can be reduced by carefully following instructions at all times while engaged in the activity. If you choose to participate in the fire truck visit, you must understand that you bear the responsibility for any injury that might occur. The Town of St. Marys does not provide accidental death, disability, dismemberment or medical expense insurance on behalf of the community group participating in the fire truck visit.
