The secretary-treasurer was Mrs. Fred Knott. The ladies first met in homes then in 1957 began to rent the vacant Presbyterian church for \$5.00 per month. In 1968 they purchased the United Church building which became the Carlingford WI hall. It was sold in 2007 due to decreasing numbers and the institute again meets in members' homes.
